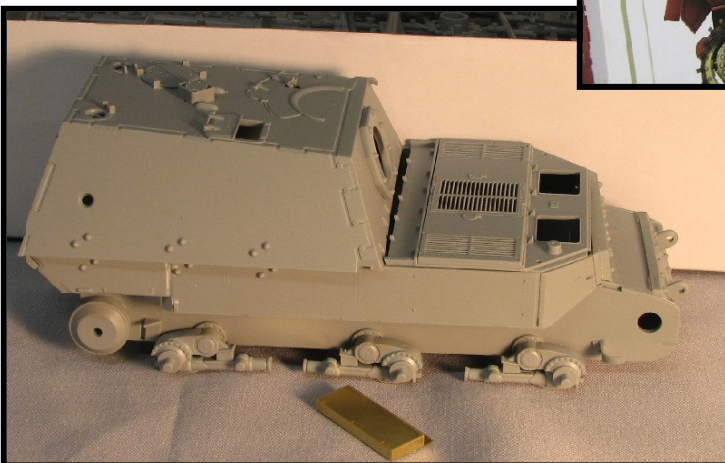


# Show and Tell

and cockpit.

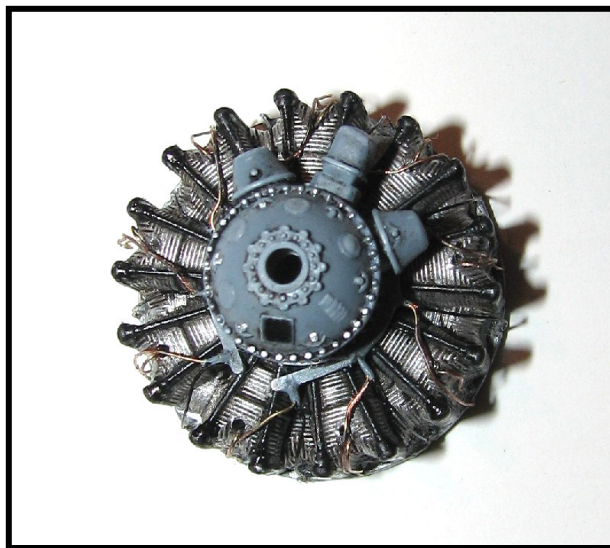
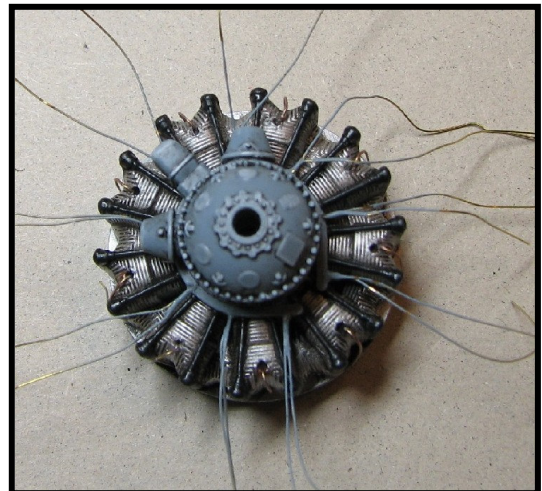
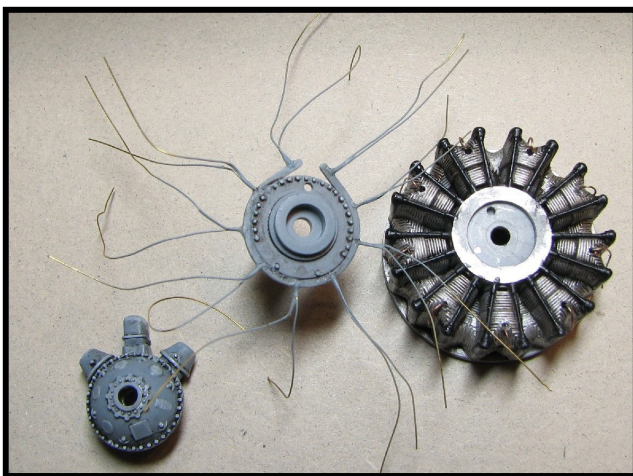


Tony Casella has started a 1/35 scale

Joe Dillman is working on engine detail for A Hasegawa F4U-7 Corsair. This is an experiment in using wire for the engine hoses and piping. He has used the kit manifold as a base and glued wire to it. There is additional wire used for piping coming out of the cylinders. Better positioning will be needed as well as highlight painting to make the wire detail more visible.
